Google Impact Challenge South Africa - Frequently Asked Questions

CRITERIA

Applications for the Google Impact Challenge are now closed. We rated all applications based on these criteria:

Community Impact: Does the proposed project create economic opportunity in South Africa? Does it improve the lives of people in our country?

Innovation: Does the project present unexpected solutions to unmet needs?

Reach: Does it have the potential to scale directly or to serve as a model for other communities? Will its scope grow over time?

Feasibility: Is the project plan (or business plan) well thought-out, and the team well-equipped to execute on it?"

PROCESS

Was every application reviewed?

Yes, we reviewed all eligible applications that we received before selecting the 12 finalists.

Who are the judges?

See our panel of judges <u>here</u>. The judges were selected based on their demonstrated commitment to social impact and their ability to rally public support for the best ideas.

How were the entries evaluated?

All eligible applications were reviewed by a team at Google. Applications were evaluated based on the Challenge <u>Rules</u> and criteria. 12 Google Impact Challenge finalists were selected and invited to pitch their project to a panel of judges. A total of four GIC winners will be chosen: three winners will be selected by the panel of judges and one winner will be selected through a public vote.

Who are the judges?

See our panel of judges <u>here</u>. The judges are selected based on both their demonstrated commitment to improving their communities and their ability to rally public support for the best ideas.

Was every single application be reviewed?

Yes, we individually reviewed all eligible applications received.

What if a judge has an affiliation with an organization selected as a finalist?

We ask judges not to be involved in scoring applications from any organization they are personally affiliated with (for example, if a judge or their family member are on the board of the organization). The application's score will be determined only by the remaining judges.

The Google Impact Challenge South Africa was an open invitation to nonprofits, social enterprises and businesses in South Africa to share their vision for innovative ways to make our community stronger and create social impact, with a specific focus on increasing economic opportunity. Winning organizations receive grant funding and Google training to help turn their ideas into reality.
